### GIFT AID

As a Community Amateur Sports Club (CASC) the club can claim 25% gift aid from HM Revenue and Customs on any donations made to the Club.

As such, it is now possible with your agreement to convert 30% of your subscription fee into a donation upon which we can claim the additional 25% gift aid. For example, for someone paying the adult membership of £105 the 30% donation amount would be £31.50 and the Club could then claim a further 25% of this amount (£7.87) as gift aid from the Government.

You must be a taxpayer and pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for this tax year at least equal to the tax that we as a CASC will claim from HM Revenue and Customs on your Gift Aid donation. If you pay Income Tax at the higher rate please include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self-Assessment tax return to receive the additional tax relief due to you.

**N.B. At the AGM held on Tuesday 29th January 2019, it was recognised that the Club should increase Subscription fees to help raise income given the clubs current financial state. However, in order not to lose members (who may themselves be financially disadvantaged) it was agreed to raise only Adult and Bowls membership fees. Making a small donation in addition to the fees (where the member is able to afford) particularly with Gift aid will help the Club survive.**

Please note that the above are requests only and are not a mandatory requirement of membership, however, by agreeing to Gift Aid, or by adding a donation or **simply paying on or before the due date** will mean you are making a positive contribution in helping to increase club income.
